Location: SERMA Club House - 2300 Spots Rd. Wedgefield, SC, 29168. Follow the Green Start Arrows on Highway 261 from Wedgefield or Pinewood.

Description: One-day, 50+ mile ride consisting primarily of single-track woods trail (with EZ-Outs) connected by dirt roads, woods roads, and paved roads. The ride will be self-guided following arrows or a route sheet.

The route will include large portions of the NEPG National Enduro trail being held the following week. RIDERS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO RIDE BOTH EVENTS.

This event is being made under a special use permit obtained through Manchester State Forest and cannot be ridden at any other time.

Manchester State Forest has a lot of users. You could encounter horses on the roads. If so, please stop, shut off your bike and let the horses pass. Please pack out all trash!!!

Requirements: YOU MUST COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING BIKE INSPECTION AT THE STARTING LINE. MUST HAVE TAG, WORKING HEADLIGHT AND TAILLIGHT AND SPARK ARRESTOR. No pass, no ride!

You and your bike must also meet all South Carolina requirements for public roadways.

This is an AMA Sanctioned event. AMA memberships will be available at Registration.

Free lunch/drink will be provided to all riders at the clubhouse.

Gas will be available at the parking area.

Schedule: Saturday registration: 4:00-6:00 PM

Sunday registration: 7:00-8:30 AM

Riders Meeting is at 8:30 AM and last rider out prior to 9:30 AM. Return by 4:00 PM.

Registration: On-line Pre-Registration opens Dec. 13th at www.serma.club. This is a club monitored pay site. Riders should expect payment confirmation within a couple of days after entry. Early signup entry fee is \$70. Beginning January 26th, the Entry fee will be \$80. (No changes, No refunds, No Swapping).

Lodging: In addition to local hotels, primitive camping and camper parking will be available at the SERMA Club House. For safety reasons, campfires will not be allowed.
